



RhD IMMUNOGLOBULIN

Free elearning course for healthcare professionals who care for pregnant women.

Aims

Since the introduction of the prophylactic RhD immunoglobulin (Ig) program, the RhD alloimmunisation rate has reduced from approximately 16% to 0.1-0.2%.

This course provides information about alloimmunisation and the development of Haemolytic Disease of the Fetus and Newborn, the identification and management of pregnant women at risk of alloimmunisation, sensitising events and the appropriate use of RhD immunoglobulin. This includes the importance of stewardship of RhD Ig and celebrating the donors contributing to the RhD Ig program.

Assessment & CPD

Includes online assessment, and a certificate for continuing professional development (CPD).

Content

Course content is based on the 'Prophylactic use of RhD immunoglobulin in pregnancy care 2021' guidelines and other relevant guidelines, evidence-based material and/or expert consensus opinion. This has been developed in collaboration with leading Australian experts in the field.
