Aims

One of the core principles of patient blood management is to optimise haemostasis and minimise blood loss. Identifying a patient's risk of bleeding preoperatively is an integral step in developing a blood management plan to minimise blood loss.

This course focuses on bleeding risk assessment for patients undergoing elective surgical procedures including:

- the risk and possible extent of blood loss related to the procedure
- patient and family history of abnormal bleeding

- preoperative identification of disorders that may affect haemostasis
- · medication history.

Assessment & CPD

Content

The course is based on Patient Blood Management Guidelines: Module 2 Perioperative, the Preoperative Bleeding Risk Assessment and Intervention Resource: Guidance for Australian Health Providers and includes evidence-based recommendations, practice points and expert opinions.
